



Dissociation and Splinter Personalities

This is part four in the study "What Is MPD". I have entitled this last article "Dissociation and Splinter Personalities." It may seem a bit confusing that I would use the term Alter Personality in the first three articles and Splinter Personality in this fourth one, so an explanation is in order. Although I have referred to these personalities as Alter Personalities in the three previous parts, they are called by other names as well, including Splinter Personality, Split Personality, Alternate Personality, Alter, Multiple Personality and Multiplicity.

I felt it would be good to use the name Splinter Personality in this fourth segment as the Psychiatric Community seems to favor this explanation of what has taken place in the mind. They believe a part of the brain has splintered off and taken on its own separate identity.

This is perfectly understandable as they have embraced the theory of Materialism, which rejects the existence of the spirit realm and are therefore limited to looking for answers in the material physical realm.

In this fourth and final article I will use two actual cases of demons the Psychiatric Community would diagnose as a Splinter Personality. We will examine both of these cases and determine whether they are a Splinter or a demon.

The first so called Splinter inhabited a thirty-two-year-old woman. It had been implanted in her Subconscious Mind through programming by Satanists, throughout her childhood and teen years. This so-called Splinter called itself Julie.

The second so called Splinter inhabited a twenty-five-year-old man and had entered him during a molestation while he was an infant. It called itself "My Little". This term "Little" is a common name for so called Splinter Personalities. I have cast out many demons who called themselves "Little One" as well as several who called themselves "Little Sarah", "Little Debbie", and "Little Tammy."

In Part One which I entitled "Myth of MPD" I stated that the term Multiple Personality Disorder was first used by two psychiatrists in the early 1950's to describe a mental disorder where two or more personalities are inhabiting one single individual.

In 1998 a new term Dissociative Identity Disorder was introduced to replace the term Multiple Personality Disorder. I explained the reason for the name change was that while Multiple Personality Disorder describes the mental condition (Multiple Personalities) it did not describe what caused the condition. The new name Dissociative Identity Disorder describes the cause (Dissociation) and the results (Identity Disorder). However, I entitled this four-part study Multiple Personality Disorder or MPD as it continues to be the most widely recognized term among the general public.

What is Dissociation?

Dissociation is a term that describes what the Conscious Mind experiences when it disconnects from its conscious surroundings to avoid being subjected to circumstances too traumatic or painful for it to endure. In most cases it is extreme trauma due to tragedy, abuse, fear or pain. However, once the ability to dissociate is learned, some individuals will begin to dissociate out of curiosity or for entertainment. This is a dangerous practice as we will learn in our study.

When the Conscious Mind disconnects, the Unconscious Mind, which is normally only active during the dreaming state, must take the place of the Conscious Mind to operate motor skills such as walking, talking, driving, etc. and therefore must endure the traumatic incident. The experience is then stored in the Subconscious Mind. When the Conscious Mind reconnects, it will not be aware of the experience and therefore not have the ability to recall the memory.

Dissociation could be described as the act of disconnecting from conscious awareness until the trauma passes and then locking the memory in a 'suitcase' and storing it in the basement of the brain, out of sight from our Conscious Mind.

Unfortunately, the emotions were not able to leave with the Conscious Mind and therefore were subjected to the trauma. Many individuals who are emotionally unstable have experienced extreme trauma which inflicted damage to their emotions, without any conscious awareness of the experience because they had Dissociated. This brings confusion and discouragement to those who know Christ and see the promises in scripture that says He heals the wounded and brokenhearted (Luke 4:18). They may spend their entire adult life looking elsewhere for answers because their leaders affirm Christians cannot be bothered by demons so they look elsewhere.

The ability to dissociate is not a malady or dysfunction of the mind. It is an inherent trait endowed by God that acts as a defense mechanism to protect the person from permanent mental damage due to trauma from abuse, tragedy, fear or pain. However, like other gifts God has given to mankind, the enemy can take this ability and use it to bring many into the bondage labeled Multiple Personalities.

Dissociation Identity Disorder

American Psychiatric Association defines Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), as follows,

"A mental condition whereby a single individual evidences two or more distinct identities or personalities, each with its own pattern of perceiving and interacting with the environment. The diagnosis requires that at least two personalities routinely take control of the individual's behavior and that there is associated memory loss that goes beyond normal forgetfulness, often referred to as "losing time" or acute Dissociative Amnesia."

They are accurate in their diagnosis of the disorder but their conclusions as to what has caused the disorder are incorrect. As stated previously, they are limited to looking for answers in the material realm, having embraced the theory of "Materialism" which rejects the existence of the spirit realm.

The Secular Therapist must look for answers in the material body and have therefore concluded that the mind has splintered and the splinters have become a second and third, etc. Splinter Personality.

Dissociation and Demons

As was stated previously, the ability to dissociate is not a malady or a dysfunction in the brain but an inherent trait given to mankind by God that works like a safety valve; too much pressure and the valve is activated and the Conscious Mind disconnects. Then after the trauma is past, the Conscious Mind returns and assumes its normal function.

When one experiences a traumatic event due to tragedy, fear or pain in the journey through life, and they dissociate, there is very little probability of any negative effects, such as demonic entry. But if the trauma is prolonged as in the case of Satanic Ritual Abuse, Sadistic Ritual Abuse or any other type of abuse over a prolonged period of time, demons will be attracted to the scene of the trauma and wait for an opportunity to enter.

Satanic Programming

If an individual is a victim being programmed by Satanists for the purpose of implanting Splinters, the victim will be subjected to pain or fear to force dissociation. The Programmer will then command a demon to enter, who will take the identity of a Splinter Personality. This demon will be given a name, personality, and job description (child, killer, seductress, etc.). A second demon will also be implanted to act as a trigger. The trigger demon will be activated by a sight, smell, sound, taste, color, picture, etc. The trigger will cause the individual to dissociate and the Splinter Personality will then surface and take the role of the Conscious Mind.

Human Will and Demonic Entry

The Human Will is the Gatekeeper of the Soul. The Human Will is the organ of the soul that says yes or no to any choice affecting the individual including Christ's offer of forgiveness and eternal life. The Human Will may choose eternal life or eternal damnation. God has made the Human will the strongest force on earth. It can say no to God or Satan. If this were not true Satan could make everyone of us murderers, rapists and cannibals.

The Human Will works with the Conscious Mind. The Conscious Mind presents the facts of the situation to the Human Will who then examines the facts and says yes or no. When the Conscious Mind rests during sleep there is nothing for the Human Will to do so it rests as well. This is how demons can cause us to have horrible nightmares that we are unable to stop. It is because the Conscious Mind and therefore the Human Will is asleep.

The same is true when one Dissociates. The Conscious Mind is not present and therefore the Human Will is inactive. This allows demons to enter. As stated earlier, the chance of a demon being ready and available just at the moment a person experiences a traumatic incident is highly improbable. It is only when a person repeatedly dissociates over a prolonged period of time, whether because of abuse or they choose to dissociate out of curiosity or pleasure, they become vulnerable to a demon gaining entry.

If a demon enters at this point, it will live the experience and claim the memory as its property and its home. The demon has become the sole owner of that single memory. The Conscious Mind was absent and the Unconscious Mind was not required to operate the motor skills of the body to interface with the world around it because the demon stepped in front of the Unconscious Mind living the experience and assuming ownership of the memory.

Voices of Splinters

If the demon does not gain strength from repeated Dissociation, it will have little influence in the individual's life. It will live in that memory, claiming it for its own but never having the strength to overpower the Human Will and surface in the person's life. I have cast out hundreds of Splinter Personalities that were infants with a life span of minutes or hours. I have discovered whole groups that have taken the name "Voices" but have never done more than speak to the individual.

The individual could plainly hear their voices but assumed they were their own thoughts.

Levels of Dissociation

There are different levels of Dissociation. The Apostle Paul relates his experience of being caught up to heaven (2 Corinthians 12:2-4). He couldn't tell whether he was caught up in his body or just his Spirit and Conscious Mind. The Apostle John had a similar experience (Revelations 4:1-2). He states he was caught up in the spirit. His choice of words, "in the spirit" would seem to indicate it was an out of body dissociation.

I have had many individuals relate their experience of dissociating. Some of these experiences were before coming to me, but many experienced this while I was praying over them in my office. I have identified four levels or types of Dissociation.

1. Out of Body Dissociation

The individual is outside the body observing the events taking place in the physical world as a spectator. This mode of dissociation is sometimes referred to as Astral Projection due to the fact that those involved in occult or New Age activity dissociate out of curiosity or pleasure to travel and explore the astral plane. In this case the body is left in a safe place and lies in a comatose state. Actress Shirley McClain shared her experience in her book, *Out on a Limb*, published in 1983.

With Out of Body Dissociation where the Conscious Mind is observing the physical body, it is unlikely for a demon to enter and take the identity of a Splinter Personality because the body is in an unconscious state. It is being guarded by the Conscious Mind.

But if the person wanders too far into the Astral Plane and leaves the body unguarded, which is sometimes the case, it is possible for a demon to enter and take up residence as a Splinter Personality.

2. Mental Dissociation.

In this type of dissociation, the conscious mind mentally separates itself from the body and travels to another place. It is completely unaware of what the body is experiencing. This type of dissociation is what victims of abuse usually experience. The Conscious Mind (Self) has been traumatized and seeks a safe place to hide or a place of comfort. It may even sleep. Mental Dissociation is a perfect opportunity for a demon to enter as a Splinter Personality.

3. Programmed Dissociation

The Conscious Mind is forced to dissociate from fear, pain or both, but is still controlled by the Satanist Programmer even after it dissociates. The Programmer may also torture the Conscious Mind or imprison it in a coffin, torture chamber, chains, a cave, a file cabinet, or even in a pseudo hell. This type of Dissociation is often employed for implanting Splinter Personalities.

4. Triggered Dissociation

This may result from a traumatic experience from the past or previous programming by others. If it results from a previous trauma, the trigger will usually be a sight, sound, smell or feeling connected to that traumatic memory. The victim will normally experience the same type of dissociation they experienced during the original incident.

They may lapse into a state of Dissociation, with a demon taking control, and no noticeable change in behavior.

If the victim dissociates after a programmed trigger, the Conscious Mind will either be imprisoned by the programmer or escape to another place to hide, but does not stay to observe.

The trigger is what the programmer chooses it to be and it can be a word, color, sight, smell, sound or hand signal.

It may even be something as innocent as a kind greeting. This was a trigger in a woman I wrote a book about in 2007, entitled *To Hell with Sarah*. Any gesture of kindness, whether a nod or a "hello" from a man triggered sexual demons in Sarah.

In all of the above types of dissociation, the demon who has assumed the role of a Splinter Personality will experience the very real physical, and emotional pain the victim's body is subjected to.

I shared in Part 3 entitled "Amy the Alter" about the Alter/Splinter Amy telling me it got tired of taking the abuse and pain for Sarah, so it refused to surface. Whenever Amy refused to surface, it gave opportunity for another demon to step in and endure the abuse, becoming another Splinter Personality.

Satanic Ritual Abuse and Dissociation

In the case of Satanic Ritual Abuse where Dissociation is used for the programming of the mind, Dissociation is forced by inflicting pain or striking fear in the victim. A demon is then commanded to enter the victim, given a name and a trigger that will cause the victim to automatically Dissociate when triggered and the demon will surface and take control of the individual's action.

The trigger may be a color, a picture, a song, a smell, a word, a phone ringing, or a command given by the programmer.

Some demons that have entered through Dissociation forced by Satanist Programmers and taken the identity of a Splinter Personality, are so powerful they are able to overpower the Human Will, forcing their way into the person's behavior when triggered. The Splinter will be the most powerful demon in the memory but will usually have multiple demons under it.

The Programmer will have to stay actively involved in controlling the victim in order for the Splinter Personality to maintain its strength. Otherwise, the Human Will, within approximately twenty years will eventually grow strong enough to prevent the Splinter Personality from surfacing, except when the person is very tired, confused, asleep or fallen in sin. Most of the individuals I have dealt with had started to regain strength over the programs by the time they had reached forty to fifty years old.

Noticeable Symptoms of Dissociative Identity Disorder

The Psychiatric Community has identified recognizable symptoms which usually accompany Dissociative Identity Disorder. Not all of the symptoms will be present in every case, but some will be recognized with any victim of this disorder. At least one Splinter or Alter Personality will always be present, along with some of these listed below.

- Time Loss
- Out of Body Experiences
- Trances
- Compulsive Behavior (rocking, swaying, repetitive speech)
- Suicidal Tendencies
- Self-Mutilation
- Outbursts of Rage
- Panic Attacks
- Sleep Disorders (insomnia, night terrors, sleep walking)
- Phobias (darkness, snakes, water, heights, closets, colors, time of day)
- Flashbacks
- Depression
- Mood Swings
- Alcohol and Drug Abuse
- Physical Violence

These symptoms are real and are the result of actual damage done to the mind. Healing is a prerequisite. Jesus said in Luke 4:18,

*"He has sent Me to heal the Brokenhearted.
To proclaim freedom for the Captives."*

"

Freedom from D.I.D. can only come from achieving both of these. First, praying for God to heal the wounds and then, casting out the demons that have inflicted the wounds.

Dissociation and Integration

The Psychiatric Community, having concluded the physical mind has splintered, have developed what they believe is the proper procedure for correcting Dissociative Identity Disorder. The procedure is called "Integration" or "Integrating the Selves".

The Splinter Julie

The woman I referred to previously as the first case we would consider, was a thirty-two-year-old woman who had the Splinter Personality who called itself Julie. She began to experience symptoms resulting from the abuse inflicted during the Programming she was subjected to from childhood into her teen years. This type of programming was called Somatic Directives Programming.

Somatic Directives Programming

Satanists Programmers employ a type of programming called Somatic Directives Programming. The word somatic is the adjective derived from the Greek word *soma* which is translated in the English language as body.

Somatic Directives Programming uses the same systematic torture to inflict wounds in the victim as other types of programming. The Programmer commands the memories of the torture consisting of burns, bleeding, swelling and bruising to remain in the cells of the body where the wound was inflicted.

Should the victim ever choose to disobey the programmed commands or reveal the cults activities, these memories in the body are triggered, causing the victim to experience the original injuries inflicted during the programming.

This woman had unintentionally done something to trigger the memories, and she started bleeding out her eyes, and bruises, burns and swelling appeared all over her body. She knew she had been programmed as a child and suspected the programming had something to do with it, but she was hoping a doctor might help her. The woman met with a doctor and allowed him to examine her.

The doctor was baffled and referred her to Stanford University Hospital. The medical team was intrigued and offered free treatment but only if she would agree to submit to a Psychiatrist for therapy. She agreed to meet the Psychiatrist,

who upon examining her, diagnosed her as having Multiple Personalities. The Therapist explained these Multiples as Splinters of her personality.

The Therapist explained the procedure called Integration and instructed her to allow the Splinter Personalities to surface. Having been around demons her whole life, she knew what they were, but reluctantly agreed in order to get the medical help.

The Therapist didn't realize what she was asking of the woman. She didn't understand that it is not possible for the Conscious Mind to remain active and present while a demon they refer to as a Splinter surfaced. They cannot simultaneously function. The Conscious Mind must acquiesce and vacate conscious surroundings.

When the Conscious Mind vacates consciousness, it must go somewhere else. It may in some cases hover in the proximity of the realm but only as an observer.

Each time this woman surrendered her Human Will and let the Splinter named Julie surface, it became stronger and her Human Will became weaker. After the third or fourth visit, allowing Julie to surface, it completely overpowered her Will and remained up for weeks at a time.

I learned about this woman's condition from her sister who came to me for help. She said every time she called to talk to her sister a demon named Julie answered the phone and refused to let her speak to her sister. Julie would curse, belittle and threaten to kill the woman she was inhabiting, and the sister I was praying for, if she didn't quit calling.

I started praying for this woman who had come to me regarding her sisters problem after discovering she also had many demons claiming to be Splinters of her personality. I cast them out in the same way I cast out demons of fear or anger or rape.

This demon the Psychiatrist was convinced was a Splinter Personality had the following characteristics:

1. Julie refused to allow the woman she was inhabiting to retake control.
2. Julie cursed and belittled the woman she inhabited.

3. Julie refused to let the sister speak to the woman she inhabited.
4. Julie threatened to kill both the woman she inhabited and the sister.

Do these characteristics, which the pseudo Splinter Julie exhibited, sound like a fragile delicate Splinter of the woman's personality or do they sound like what we would expect a demon from hell to sound like? Julie was hateful, spiteful, vile and threatened to kill both of the women. I'll let you make your own judgment. But, I have no doubt that this vile creature was nothing more than a demon, regardless of what the Psychiatric Community had chosen to call it.

In time the symptoms of bruising and bleeding of the Somatic Directive Programming eventually disappeared and the woman discontinued her hospital visits and therapy. The Splinter Julia had been released through the Somatic Directive Programming but then strengthened through the Psychiatrist therapy of Integration. Julia continued to plague the woman until the woman's Human Will became strong enough to force it back into the Subconscious Mind and the woman I was praying with was able to once again make contact with her sister.

I haven't stayed in contact with the woman with the Somatic Directives Programming and therefore don't know if she is still plagued with her Splinter Personalities. One thing I do know, is this so-called Splinter Personality Julie exhibited all the same characteristics of the thousands of demons I have cast out of others in my deliverance ministry.

My Little

The second case involves a twenty-five-year-old man who came to me asking for help to get free from some powerful tormenting demons. I asked him to explain the symptoms. He listed a plethora of problems including fear, paranoia, anxiety, demons of molestation and rape, phobias and obsessions. The most troubling was the obsession with wearing diapers.

I asked him how long he had had this obsession, and he said as long as he could remember. I then ask if he knew what had caused this obsession? He said he vaguely remembered someone molesting him when he was an infant and he suspected this obsession was the result.

I then asked him if he had ever carried out this obsession? Hanging his head in shame, he admitted that although he was usually able to resist the urge, he had on several occasions given in and worn one around the house.

I set him up with several appointments and started the task of freeing him of his tormenters. I have been doing this enough years to know I was going to have to wade through a myriad of weaker demons as they surfaced, before I could reach the ones I was really after. They were the ruler demons.

In each session, I started with the one he had struggled with the previous week. It might be fear, anxiety or sexual demons who would fondle his genitals and rectum trying to sexually arouse him to get him to give in and have sex with them. Sometimes they would overpower him and violently rape him.

I had prayed with him six or seven times when he came in for his scheduled appointment and shared with me, he had met a team of Deliverance Ministers at a Church in another city who had told him one of his problems was he had an infant Splinter Personality they needed to Integrate back into his Person.

They were no doubt sincere well-meaning Christians who had accepted this secular theory of Splinter Personalities and thought they were helping this young man by Integrating this infant Splinter but they were not helping him.

I attempted to explain to him their well meant but erroneous method, but I could see he was not persuaded so I didn't pursue it. I decided I would discontinue praying for him as I had no intention of spending time undoing other people's mistakes.

Then I quickly decided on another approach. I commanded this pseudo infant Splinter to tell me its name. I repeated the command numerous times but eventually it said,

"My name is My Little"

That started a conversation with this pseudo Splinter that I recorded as it spoke. This demon identified itself as the same entity the Psychiatric Community and the sincere Christian Ministry Team had identified as a poor little infant Splinter Personality of this man.

I share this conversation and ask you the reader to be the judge whether this entity sounds to you like a helpless little infant Splinter or an evil demon.

I commanded this demon to tell me,

"Are you the one who makes him wear the diaper?"

It glared at me for about thirty seconds and then started growling. I repeated my question.

"Yes, I am", it said as it grinned at me.

It then started contorting his body and throwing him around on the couch. After several minutes it turned and looked at me and started hissing like a snake.

"I hate you", it said and turned the man's hand into the shape of a a claw and lashed out and tried to claw my eyes. I evaded his attempt and asked him,

"What do you think of Jesus?"

"I hate Him too."

I decided it was time for the battle to begin. I repeated three or four times,

"I command you to go in Jesus Name."

"Make me, make me, make me," it repeated and then started saying, *"No! No! No! No! No! No!"*

It arched the man's back and roared. Then it started gritting the man's teeth and tried to rip the leather couch with both hands.

It made grotesque faces, protruding the man's tongue out to a seemingly impossible length. It folded the man's arms across his chest and acted like a pouting child. It then started alternating between mumbling and then hissing, over and over for about three minutes.

Then it started throwing the man from one side of the couch to the other. This went on for about five minutes while I continued to rebuke it and command it to

leave in Jesus name. Suddenly it stopped and looked at me with this evil smirk and said,

"I like humiliating him by making him wear the diaper."

"Do you want to kill him?" I asked.

"No, I want to do worse."

I commanded it several times to tell me how old the man was when it entered him but all it would say was,

"My Little."

It then protruded his tongue again like a snake and it hissed while his head darted back and forth in a snakelike fashion. It would do that for several minutes and then start laughing with a wild demonic laugh. This probably went on for a good ten minutes and then it said,

"I don't like Jesus. I love evil."

I was tired of the conversation. I had all the evidence I needed to know this was just a demon, cunning enough to masquerade as a Splinter Personality for the professionals, but a demon just the same.

I started commanding it to go in Jesus name. I continued this for maybe two minutes. Then something happened that made me know this demon was not long for this world.

An Angel showed up. I rarely see into the spirit realm, but I can always tell when an Angel shows up because of the reaction of the demon I'm fighting.

I was jazzed when all the sudden an Angel grabbed this demon's arm and stretched it out to full length away the man's body. The demon screamed,

"Let go of my arm and quit choking me". It started screaming again and again, *"Why are you hurting me?" "Let go of my arm and quit choking me. You're hurting me."*

The Angel had its arm stretched out for about ten minutes and I could almost see the battle going on in the spirit realm. The demon was flopping all over the couch trying to get away but the Angel had its arm held tight. It finally quit struggling after about fifteen minutes, but its tongue continued to protrude like a snake until finally the young man's body relaxed and he opened his eyes and smiled and said, *"It's gone."*

The entire battle to get this pseudo "Splinter" out took one- and one-half hours. I made the statement before sharing this experience, that I would let you, the reader, be the judge. Was this a demon or an infant Splinter of the man's personality?

These are the questions I would suggest you ask yourself in determining what this entity was.

1. Would an infant Splinter say it hated Jesus?
2. Would an infant Splinter say it loved evil?
3. Would an infant Splinter say it liked humiliating this man?
4. Would an infant Splinter say it would like to do worse than kill this man?
5. Would an infant Splinter roar and hiss like a snake?
6. Would an infant Splinter throw this man around trying to hurt him?
7. Would an infant Splinter try to claw my eyes out?
8. Would an Angel wrestle, choke and hurt an infant Splinter?

The Psychiatric Community is sincere in its search for answers for the broken people that they try to help, but it has been deceived by Satan in an elaborate hoax regarding Multiple Personalities.

Many Christian Counselors have bought in to this deception and have put God's people on a worthless treadmill of therapy that can never help them to obtain freedom.

It has been said,

"A man with an experience is never at the mercy of a man with a theory."

I have had too many experiences in dealing with this demonic deception the Psychiatric Community has diagnosed Multiple Personality Disorder to feel intimidated by their credentials, their degrees, their theories or their numbers.

Quite the opposite. I feel honored to be in the same position as Martin Luther when he defied the Conventional Wisdom of the Age, the credentials of the learned and the sheer masses of the clergy in 1517 A.D. when he declared.

"The just shall live by faith."

Rom. 1:17

I present these four articles to the Church with the hope that these truths may open the eyes of those who have been confused about the mystery regarding Multiple Personality Disorder, and offer hope to those victims of this hellish Bondage.
